

Houses Asset Pack

This pack was originally designed to support my Leek & Manifold Route. It contains houses & domestic buildings specific to that route but is also one of a number of packs that contains things that might be of use to other route builders.

Contents – see pictures

The basic structure of the filenames shows the type of house followed by the building material. In many cases there are a version of each house in each building material. Hence the filename of, for instance, Rmax_CottageA_msg1. This is a type A cottage in millstone grit (grey) with dark weathered mortar between stones. It is a dark gray basic house.

Basic House Designs

Type A	Simple two up two down. Peak district/ Staffordshire.
Type B	Same as Type A but with a gabled dormer window at one end
Type C	Row of two Type B with end doors and windows and gable windows
Type D	Type A cottage but with outbuildings and extensions attached
Type X	A T floor pattern cottage based on type A design and dimensions
Row A1	A terrace of 5 type A cottages but with end wall entrances and rear extensions
Row A2	A simple linear row of 3 type A cottages
Row X	Row of 2 type X cottages
Shop 1	Waterhouses village shop – complex layout corner shop
Wetton Cottage	Wetton Mill cottage
Ecton Folly	Mad design of Victorian folly with copper clad steeple

Building Materials

MSG1	Millstone Grit with black / dirty mortar.
MSG2	Millstone Grit with light sandy mortar. Posh with white painted window sills and frames
MSG3	Millstone Grit with black / dirty mortar. Different doors & windows from MSG1
SS1	Sand Stone or cleaned Millstone Grit with black / dirty mortar.
SS2	Sand Stone or cleaned Millstone Grit with sandy mortar. Posh like MSG2
